

Course Set-up

On-Course Items

- All rakes have been removed from the course. Please use your club / feet to smooth out the sand as best you can after use.
- Do not use ball washers, these have been covered to discourage anyone touching them.
- Do not use the benches out on the course.
- Bins are also out of use to prevent transmission of the virus and have been removed or covered.
- Course markers are not to be touched or removed from their position on the course and should be treated as immovable objects during play.

Hole and Flagstick

- Please do not touch the flagsticks out on the course, do not remove them from the cups.
- Cups now have a tube in them to prevent the ball falling below surface level of the green. The ball is considered holed if it touches the tube.

Practice Areas

- The driving range and pro-shop remain closed and locked.
- The chipping and putting practice areas remain closed and must not be used.

Before the Round

Bookings

- Please use the online booking system accessible through the members area on the www.whitehavengolfclub.com website and stick to your tee time.
- Current guidance available from England Golf permits the following groupings:
 - Individuals playing golf on their own.
 - Two-balls comprising of individuals from different households
 - Members of the same household playing in two, three or four-balls.
- Tee intervals will remain at 10 minutes, please arrive promptly.

Arrival and Waiting to Play

- On arrival at the course please do not park directly adjacent to other vehicles to help maintain social distancing. Please remain in your car until you need to unpack your equipment immediately before you move to the putting green / 1st tee.
- The clubhouse will remain locked with the changing rooms inaccessible. Unfortunately this means there will be no welfare facilities available on the property.
- Score Cards will be available on the windowsill near the rear entrance of the clubhouse.
- Access to the playing area will be around the back of the clubhouse past the restaurant.

During the Round

Teeing Areas

- Please keep two metres apart at teeing areas due to the normal close proximity of golfers to one another when tee shots are being played.

General

- Golfers are to stay more than two metres apart when walking to the ball, searching for a ball and playing shots.
- Do not touch stray balls.

Bunkers

- With no rakes allowed on the course, golfers are to make their very best efforts to smooth the sand using their club and/or their feet.

Putting Green

- Golfers to keep two metres apart on the putting greens and not to touch the flagstick

After the Round

- On completion of your round please move back to the car park via the front of the clubhouse past the golfer's room.
- Return to your vehicle to pack your equipment and leave the course immediately.
